INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MUST FILE:

A person who is licensed by the United States Customs Service to act as a custom house broker and who holds a Texas Customs Broker License issued by the Comptroller's office.

WHEN TO FILE:

The due date of the quarterly report is the 20th day of the month following the quarterly reporting period. For example, the first quarterly report of a year covers the months of January, February, and March and the due date is April 20th. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the next business day will be the due date. Failure to receive the correct report form from the Comptroller does not relieve a customs broker of the responsibility to file a report on time by the due date. To be considered timely filed, a report must be either postmarked or received by the Comptroller on or before the due date.

"Total value of the tangible personal property" means the total amount of all sales prices, as shown on receipts and invoices from retailers who sold the property for which the licensed customs broker issued certifications for export.

"Total amount of the corresponding tax for which the Customs Broker issued certifications of export" means the total amount of all state and local sales and use taxes for Texas, as shown on receipts and invoices from retailers who sold the property for which the licensed customs broker issued certifications of export.

"Total amount of tax refunded in accordance with certifications of export" means the total amount of all state and local sales and use taxes for Texas which the licensed customs broker obtained assignments of right of refund from purchasers and received refunds of taxes from retailers.

You must contact the Texas State Comptroller's field office in your area with outlet location changes or name changes.

A license fee will be required for all new locations.
