## Instructions for Reporting Excess Highway Fines and Fines Under CCP 45.051(a)

Transportation Code Section 542.402 applies to cities and counties with a population under 5,000.

**Item 3 -** <u>Highway fines</u> - fines collected for offenses under V.T.C.A., Transportation Code, Title 7, Vehicles and Traffic.

Fines under Code of Criminal Procedures 45.051(a): - In issuing the order of deferral, the judge may impose a fine on the defendant in an amount not to exceed the amount of the fine that could be imposed on the defendant as punishment for the offense. The fine may be collected at any time before the date on which the period of probation ends. The judge may elect not to impose the fine for good cause shown by the defendant. If the judge orders the collection of a fine under this subsection, the judge shall require that the amount of the fine be credited toward the payment of the amount of the fine imposed by the judge. An order of deferral under this subsection terminates any liability under a bond given for the charge. Note: Please include all fines in calculating the city's/county's total highway fines collected.

Item 9 - No report is required if your calculation shows no payment is due.
If Item 3 is LESS THAN Item 2, this report is not yet required to be filed.
If Item 3 is GREATER THAN Item 2, please complete the report and remit the amount due and payable on line 9.

Note: A financial statement must be filed when the city's/county's current highway fines and fines under CCP 45.051(a) reach 20 percent of your revenue less federal funds and bond proceeds. The financial statements and notification must be filed within 120 days of the end of your fiscal year.
