Dear Taxpayer:

According to our records, your business could be directly affected by changes made by House Bill 1831, enacted by the 81st Legislature, 2009. Beginning June 1, 2010, retail sellers of prepaid wireless telecommunications service must collect a prepaid wireless 9-1-1 emergency service fee from customers. The fee will be 2 percent of the purchase price of prepaid wireless telecommunications service that permit access to 9-1-1 emergency services purchased through any means.

Prepaid wireless telecommunication service means a mobile telecommunication service that is paid for in advance and allows a person to access 9-1-1 emergency communication services.

If you sell prepaid wireless telecommunications service, you must file a quarterly report and pay the fee to the Comptroller on or before the 30th day of the month following each calendar quarter. Since the effective date of the new fee does not coincide with the quarterly filing period, any fees collected in June 2010 will be reported and paid on or before July 30, 2010. Reports must be filed even if no fee is due.

If you do not sell prepaid wireless telecommunications service, please check the box below and return this letter to the address shown no later than April 30, 2010. If you do not inform the Comptroller that you are not responsible for collecting the fee, you will still be liable for collection of the fee.
